

# **Frequently Asked Questions!**

## **What will the sessions be about?**

## **What does per person/double occupancy mean?**

This means that each person who is on the cruise must pay the per person rate. Double occupancy is required (single folks can pay for 2 people or try to pair up with another single cruiser).

## **Can I bring a guest who is not a CTRS?**

Of course! The cruise is a ‘public cruise’ and anyone can attend. If they are your guest, they may also receive the group rate as a courtesy to you!

## **Can my children attend?**

Yes! Minors must have an adult over the age of 21 in the room with them. There may be cabins still available for up to 4 people. Day care services are available on the ship (there may be a charge and age restrictions).

## **What if I do not have a significant other to bring and do not want to pay for the double occupancy?**

We can assist matching you up with another professional. Many people have been emailing each other trying to pair up!

## **Are upgrades available if I do not want an inside cabin?**

Yes, you may upgrade to whichever room you like! Just an FYI ... an inside cabin does not have a window. There may be additional charges for upgrades.

## **Are meals included?**

YES! All meals are included and there are upgrades available if you wish! Food is available 24 hours a day; room service charge may apply.

## **Is travel insurance offered?**

Yes, for an additional cost of \$29

## **Will the sessions pertain to my job?**
